



Olmstead v. L.C.

1999 US Supreme Court ruling

- Eliminated unnecessary segregation
- Mandated services be in most integrated setting appropriate to needs
- Mandated unjustified institutional isolation was a form of unlawful discrimination

Minnesota's Olmstead Plan

Began development in 201; adopted in 2015

Activities ensuring people with disabilities are living, learning, working, and enjoying in the most integrated setting possible

Opportunity to:

- Live close to their family and friends
- Live more independently
- Engage in productive employment
- Participate in community life

Dakota County Autism Grant



- #1 recommendation: staff training
- 97% agreement: libraries should integrate people with ASD into existing programs
- 89% agreement: libraries should offer special programming to people with ASD
- 57% agreement: use of the Dakota County Library website as primary method to identify available library services
- 34% disagreement: "I am aware of Dakota County Library services."




Figure 1. Experiences with Dakota County Library N = 164




Figure 4. Percent of People Finding Communication Methods for Library Services Helpful (N = 146)





Figure 5. Percent of People Indicating Given Service Would Be Useful (N = 146)

All reading levels welcome; multiple formats (e.g., print books; audiobooks; electronic books; graphic novels, etc.) supported


Participants vote on monthly themes



















Accessibility Project Team

Tools, adapted school supplies, and small equipment to support in-library use


Available first come, first served basis at the service desk







Inclusive Spaces: Calming Space at Galaxie Library

Calming Space: room designated for those on the spectrum and/or individuals with sensory sensitivities to self-regulate; includes sensory tools for hyperand hypo-sensitivity

At Dakota County Library, we want everyone to feel welcome and part of our Library community. As part of this mission, we now offer the calming space at Galaxie Library. The calming space is specially designed for individuals who need a comforting space to regulate while at the library, especially those with autism spectrum disorder, sensory processing differences or other disabilities. The calming space is available for all ages.

The space is equipped with a 💹 Calming Space Guide. This guide explains how to use the calming space and the tools and manipulatives in it, which include:

- Comfortable seating
- Adjustable lighting
- Sound machine
- · Noise-reducing headphones
- · Weighted blanket
- Visual timer
- Fidgets
- Tactile objects

Social narratives help reduce anxiety for individuals with autism and other disabilities by preparing for what is coming next. The Calming Space Social Narrative will help prepare individuals for using the calming space at Galaxie Library.


